

Innovative (online) education practices are ...

MOOCs

Let course participant contribute to a single outcome (eg. let them create a dataset together by each conducting one interview using a provided template), then share the dataset openly and analyse the data together

Developing self-paced practical exercises to make people aware of the benefits of open data

Practical

creation of videos and sharing them on free platforms like Youtube and others, teaching via Zoom or other platforms in the same category

Test the knowledge of the participants through quizzes

Next phase: more individual/small groups education for professionals

Interactive laboratories

Use social cocreation tools like Howspace

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Virtual Reality and immersive, interactive teaching classes

Give students a platform to interact. Ask specific questions to get the discussion going

online proctoring (moderated, semi moderated, not moderated/automated)

Agil and include Professional Brainstorming Services.

An innovative online education practice would be to use a suitable combination these technologies in a smart way.
