

# In online education you should (the DOs):

Include interactivity

have exercises to keep participants active or interactive and also discussion groups

Somehow create community amongst the students

Be interactive as much as possible

Change your teaching format to the digital reality - so change slides, length, assignments to facilitate digital working

Offer online Brainstorming Services and rate and discuss the results.

Involve participants, rise questions, encourage discussion, promote interactions

Give preparations so you can more quickly dive into practical exercise

Limit presentations (broadcasting)

# In online education you should (the DOs):

Interaction and communication is key

Do not leave directly at the end of a lecture, drink coffee with the students

Create interactivity

Make students turn on their camera in meetings. Take a lot of breaks to boost energy. Be interactive. Use different technologies.

Offer PDF documents for pre-readings

Group assignments without possibilities for students to meet in person

Use break out rooms

Teachers should take a more facilitating role in live online sessions

Find ways to invite students to interact (still looking how to improve on this)

# In online education you should (the DOs):

Do not format the groups yourself, they prefer selecting their own group members

In forming groups, also set up a socializing exercises

# In online education you should not (the DO NOTs)...

Make monologues

Group assignments for students without having meetings in person

avoid talking all through the entire length of lecture (if it is live) without involving the students

Neglect that online education is different from physical.
